



Mud Kitchen Care & Safety Information

Installation

The Mud Kitchen Bench must be placed on firm, stable ground. A suitable and sufficient Risk Assessment should be carried out in line with EYFS and Health ϑ Safety requirements prior to children accessing it within your outdoor learning environment.

Equipment & Resources

When providing opportunities for children to use a Mud Kitchen, it is ESSENTIAL to regularly assess the tools and equipment provided for children to use. Wear and tear can cause safety issues if not picked up, so do keep a close eye on the resources to make sure that they are in good condition.

Caring for Your Mud Kitchen Bench

To keep your mud kitchen bench in good condition we recommend you recoat the wood with Non-Toxic Furniture Oil twice a year. First clean the bench with an anti-bacterial spray and once dry, rub on a coat of oil and allow to soak in.
